The Water & Sewer Camera Technician handles sewer camera operations, jetting sewer lines, and making point type repairs of sewer lines.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS

- Operates Vac Con truck and equipment involved in the maintenance, repair, and inspection of wastewater collection lines, storm water lines, and other related structures, secures equipment upon completion of work.
- Performs all tasks related to the televising and cleaning of the City's wastewater collection system and related structures and operates a sewer camera for inspecting sewer and storm water lines.
- Maintains a safe working condition of all equipment used, performs minor repairs and reports the need for major repairs, and services and lubricates equipment as required.
- Observes, records, documents conditions, and reports observations.
- Checks job sites for potential hazards and determines precautions for safe equipment operation.
- Assembles and sets up appropriate barricades and signs at work site and performs traffic control as needed.
- Performs the full range of duties involved to the level of a Class III Wastewater Operator in the
 maintenance and repair included in the areas of wastewater collection and related structures and
 systems and wastewater plant operations when not assigned to camera operations.
- Operates a variety of hand and power tools in assigned repair and maintenance areas.
- Ensures safe adherence to safe work practices and procedures.
- Reads and interprets a variety of maps, drawings, sketches, and blueprints for assigned project areas.
- Recognizes and deals with hazards encountered in course of work.
- Prepares and maintains records and reports.
- Performs other related duties as assigned.

Requires a High School Diploma or equivalent and two (2) years of experience, or equivalent combination of education and experience.
